ATHENS WELCOMES BFF'S TOURING EXHIBITION "ART FACTOR – THE POP LEGACY IN POST-WAR ITALIAN ART"

From 1st December 2022 to 3rd February 2023, the third leg of the touring exhibition will be hosted in Athens, with a project specially designed for the Italian Cultural Institute.

Athens, 29th November 2022 – BFF Banking Group is proud to present the exhibition "ART FACTOR – The Pop Legacy in Post-War Italian Art", being staged in Athens, at the Italian Cultural Institute, from 1st December 2022 until 3rd February 2023.

This touring exhibition is the second phase of a larger project that was launched by BFF in 2020 with a book of the same name, published by *Skira editore Milan Genève Paris*. All the works illustrated in the book come from a collection of around 250 pieces, which BFF has been putting together since the 1980s and which is permanently on show at BFF's Italian offices in Milan and Rome.

After the success achieved on the first two legs, in Slovakia and Poland, a new selection of works is now on display in Greece, under the patronage of the Italian Cultural Institute in Athens. The initiative will then continue its journey to other European countries where BFF has a presence.

Maria Alicata, the exhibition's curator, commented: "The ART FACTOR project celebrates Italian Art from the second half of the 20th century, charting Italy's path towards Pop Art through the works of Valerio Adami, Franco Angeli, Enrico Baj, Lucio Del Pezzo, Gianfranco Pardi, Mario Schifano and Emilio Tadini, dating from the mid-1960s onward, and often deployed for purposes of social and cultural activism. As in the case of these artists, the exhibition itself represents the desire to engage pro-actively in a project that benefits society, proving that it is possible to combine an entrepreneurial spirit with a dedication to the arts."

Afrodite Oikonomidou, curatorial co-ordinator in Athens, stated: "Working on this project has been very exciting, a truly enriching experience. A major private company is reinforcing its links to Greece through contemporary art. To do so, it is bringing a collection of works that have helped to write the story of Italian art, and is placing them against a highly representative backdrop, in the form of the Italian Cultural Institute. This is an excellent way to drive forward the dialogue with Greece, on both the professional and cultural levels."



Christos Theodossiou, Head of Greece, BFF Banking Group, added: "We express our heartfelt thanks to all those who have helped bring this exhibition to Athens, bolstering the dialogue between the cultures of Italy and Greece, which has always been marked out by a strong affinity. The works will be on display **from 1st December**, **2022**, **to 3**rd **February**, **2023**. The exhibition is open to the public **from Monday to Friday**, **from 10:00 am to 5:00 pm**. Entry is free.
